1. Apologies

2. To approve the Minutes from the meeting held on Saturday 23rd March 2019 Approved by those present and signed by the Chairman.

3. Clerk's Report

The Clerk noted that there were lots of books for the Phone Box book swap and that a changeover would refresh the choices for children visiting again.

Correspondence with the Verderers had confirmed the opportunity to visit the Verderers Court in the summer holidays and to hold a meeting there. The Clerk would work with parents on a date that all the children could do.

4. Letter to Bretteville du Grand Caux

This had been completed and translated and the Clerk would arrange to send it to the Mayor for his presentation to the school there.

5. Stanford Rise Green Official Opening

The Clerk to compile posters from the first year of Junior PC and create a display board. The Councillors to confirm availability for attendance at the opening on Saturday 6th July.

6. Carnival Week Fete

It was agreed that the Councillors would join the Senior Council on the stand at the fete. In order to attract more visitors to stop at the stand, the Councillors had the following suggestions which could help them to raise much needed funds:

- hook a duck win a prize (the Clerk subsequently confirmed she has ducks with hooks)
 - lucky stick dip bucket of sand, lollipop sticks with numbers, win a prize (Cllr Freya will organise this)
- rock painting (senior) Cllr Pepper had previously provided this
- pluck the chicken feathers with coloured ends, certain colour wins a prize
- recycling provide examples of waste and then ask people to say whether they can

recycle or not, have a bin liner and a recycling box for them to sort the items into

- how many sweets in the jar collect names and run a prize draw
- virtual Sway treasure hunt (a map of Sway split into squares, choose a square and win a prize if correct)
- photo of somewhere in Sway guess where it is, correct ones into a draw (the Clerk to ask Melanie Seacombe for an obscure picture that might be used)
- a jigsaw of Sway

- Cllr Joshua swings need oiling
- Cllr Joshua No news on the Post Office as yet
- MotP the waste bin at the far end of Westbeams Road (by the cut) seems to be getting missed off the round (the Clerk to check up on this)
- MotP the bin outside the village hall has been removed (the Clerk to report this)
- Cllr Tarling as Chairman of the main Parish Council and host of the Annual Parish
 Assembly, Cllr Tarling noted that there were 24 speakers and over 70 people in the
 audience. He wanted to congratulate Cllr Hattie who made a presentation on behalf
 of the Junior PC. He noted that hers was one of the best received presentations of
 the evening.

The Councillors should agree a new idea for focus over the next year.

9. Date of Next Meeting

As noted above, the Clerk would work with parents on a date for a visit to the Verderers Court, encompassing a meeting of the Council as well.

10. Official 'opening' of the newly installed waste bin at Westbeams Road
