Sway Junior Parish Council unveils new waste bin

Sway Junior Parish Council identified the need for an additional waste bin, following their anti-littering campaign around the village. Westbeams Road was recognised as one of the most prolific locations for litter, probably due to the large volume of people passing through every day, to and from school.

The Junior Parish Council has funded the purchase and installation of a dog-poo bag dispenser and is responsible for replenishing the bags when stock runs low.

In addition, they obtained approval from Sway Parish Council to approach New Forest District Council (NFDC) to request the provision of a new, additional waste bin. They recommended installation on the path outside the primary school for maximum benefit.

The Junior Parish Council was delighted to receive a positive response from the Street Scene Operations team at NFDC and their thanks go to Tony Wade and his team who provided and installed a smart wooden bin.

On Saturday 8th June they officially unveiled the new bin. Sway Parish Council will fund the additional cost of emptying the new bin as part of their contract with NFDC.
